Local Partnership Continues Cape Cod Inspired Cooking Video Series

Created to spotlight Cape Cod's rich bounty of delicious seafood caught by our local small-boat fishermen, the short, lively cooking videos are funded by the [Massachusetts Seafood Marketing Grant Program](#) and [Buy Fresh Buy Local Cape Cod](#). The Deliciously Local videos encourage home chefs to try a new way of enjoying an old favorite, or to be adventurous with some of the "under-loved" species that are abundant in our waters.

"It's important to expose people to the healthy, delicious fish that our fleet is landing." says Chatham fisherman Nick Muto.

The videos present easy-to-prepare recipes, developed by Buy Fresh Buy Local Cape Cod, along with fun on-the-water footage of fishermen who catch the seafood. They will be available on the
